


# Marie Durant



Her name was Marie Durant. She was almost ten and she came from Quimper, in France. She had blue eyes and red hair.




She always used to give her mother a hand at the fish shop. They lived comfortably. She decided to make her American dream come true, when her mother died from a terrible disease. How appalling...
