Apart from that, Ciovani was an intelligent and big-hearted man who used to arrive on time at work every day.

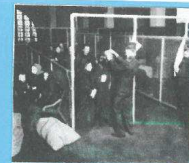
Ciovani decided to try his luck in America because the bank where he was working went bankrupt.

After waiting for five hours, he was accepted on the American soil. Then, we've lost track of him once he was cleared from Ellis Island.

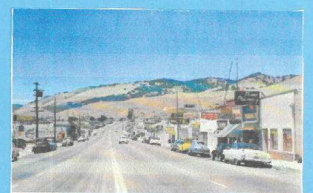


Maybe he found a job as a banker like in his native country.
